The Family Outreach and Response Program (FOR) supports and educates families and friends during the recovery process. Our purpose is to build on the strengths and resilience of families to enhance their lives. FOR strives to work with a diverse group of families and especially with those who cannot readily access support.

Philosophy

The language we use, is that of recovery. Recovery is an emerging theme within the mental health field. The model has come to Canada in recent years from various sources. Families in New Zealand, Great Britain, the United States and other countries have been empowered through the recovery model to help the people they care about. We believe that people can and do recover from serious mental health problems.

Programs

Include both individual counseling either in our offices or in client homes and our very successful 10 week Family Mental Health Recovery Series that was developed by Karyn Baker and Ann Thompson. Topics covered during the course include Pathways to Recovery, Hopelessness and the Power of Hope, the Role of the Family and Family Recovery Action Planning.

2007

- Partnered with the Mood Disorders Association of Ontario and the Schizophrenia Society of Ontario to provide early intervention in psychosis programs.
- Offered a specialized version of the Family Mental Health Recovery Series aimed at families who have a relative experiencing a first-episode psychosis.
- Partnered with the Rouge Valley Health System to provide services to the Scarborough area.
- Partnered with Midaynta, the Somali settlement agency, FOR provides counseling to the Somali community as well.
- Partnered with Community Resources Connections of Toronto and Alternatives – the East York Counseling Service hosted the successful 2 day International Recovery Perspectives conference at the University of Toronto featuring 350 attendees and speakers from around the world.
